

NAME

bsdcat — expand files to standard output

SYNOPSIS

bsdcat [options] [files]

DESCRIPTION

bsdcat expands files to standard output.

OPTIONS

bsdcat typically takes a filename as an argument or reads standard input when used in a pipe. In both cases decompressed data is written to standard output.

EXAMPLES

To decompress a file:

```
bsdc at example.txt.gz > example.txt
```

To decompress standard input in a pipe:

```
cat example.txt.gz | bsdc at > example.txt
```

Both examples achieve the same results - a decompressed file by redirecting output.
